FUNDING AND ELIGIBILITY

The Adult programme is funded through the devolved Adult Skills Fund for West Yorkshire. The Mayor of West Yorkshire and the West Yorkshire Combined Authority are investing £65 million a year to improve skills across West Yorkshire - particularly among those who need it most.

Am I eligible for financial support?

You may be entitled to fee remission on eligible courses through the Adult Skills Fund.

In particular, the following people may be entitled to fully funded access to training:

- Unemployed and seeking work
- Wanting to achieve Level 2 in maths or English for the first time
- Earning less than £26,800 year
- Wanting to achieve basic digital skills
- Wanting to achieve your first full Level 2 or Level 3 (GCSE or A-Level equivalent) qualification

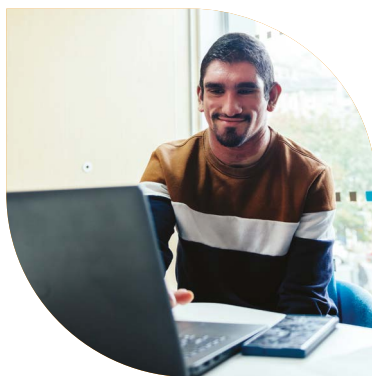
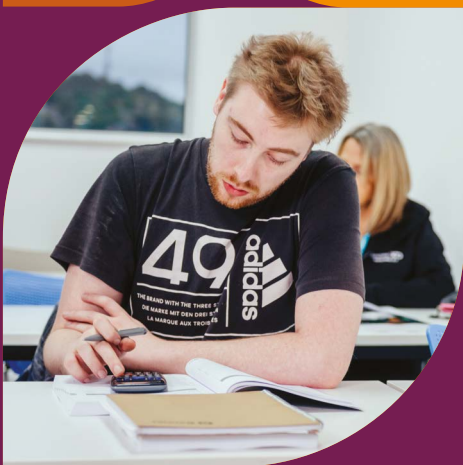

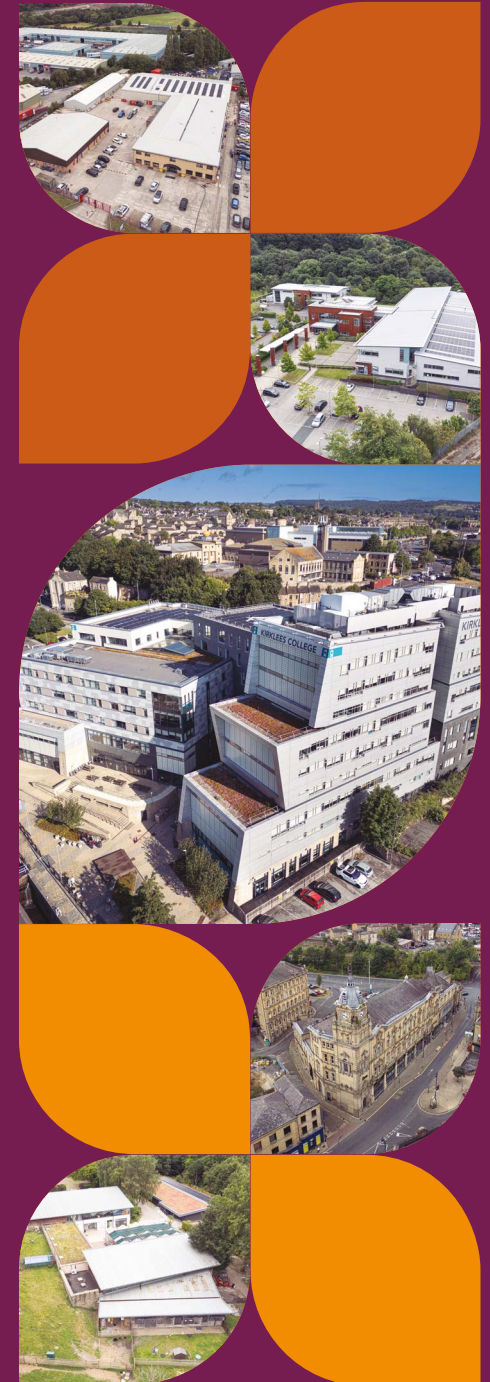
